

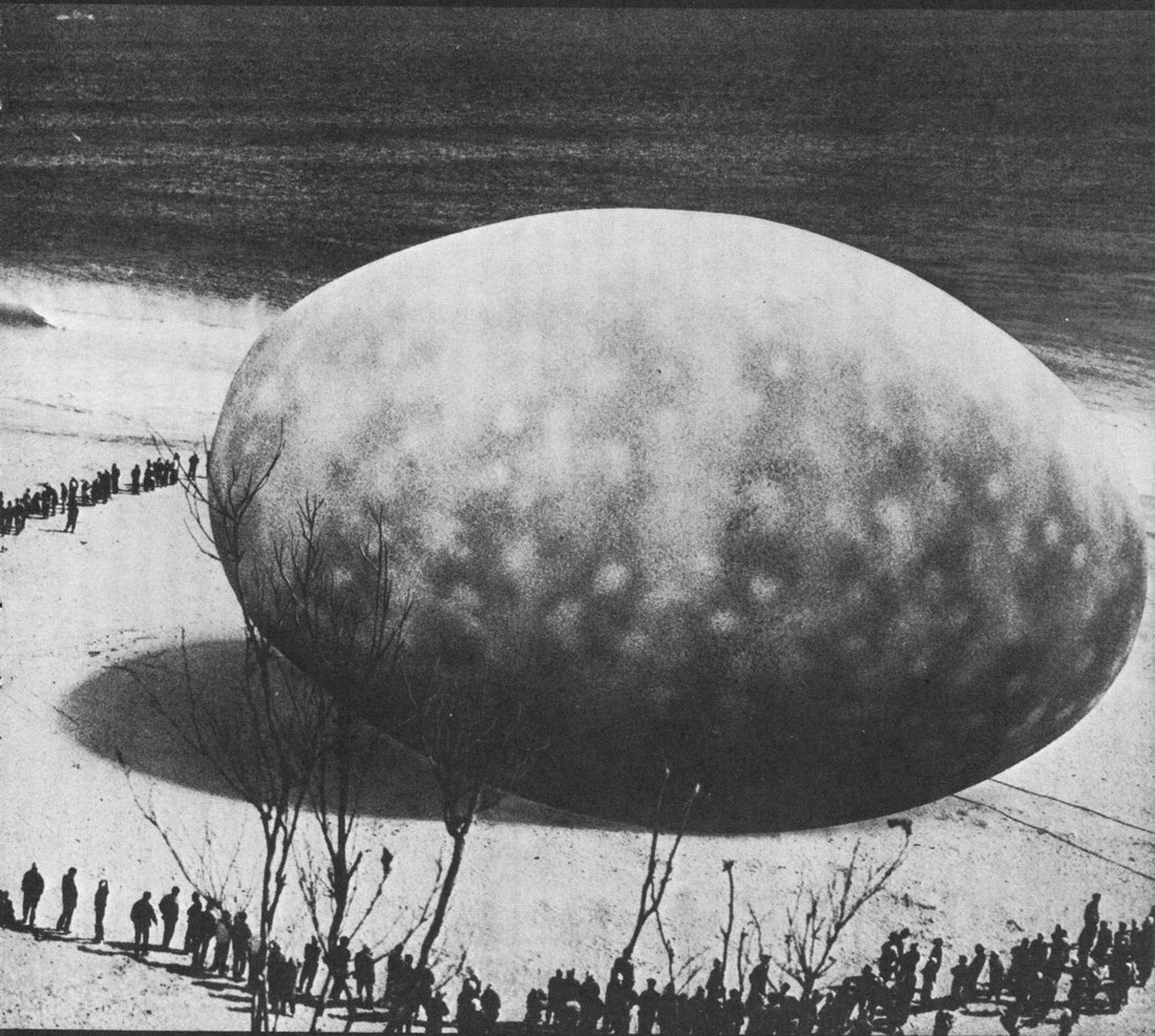

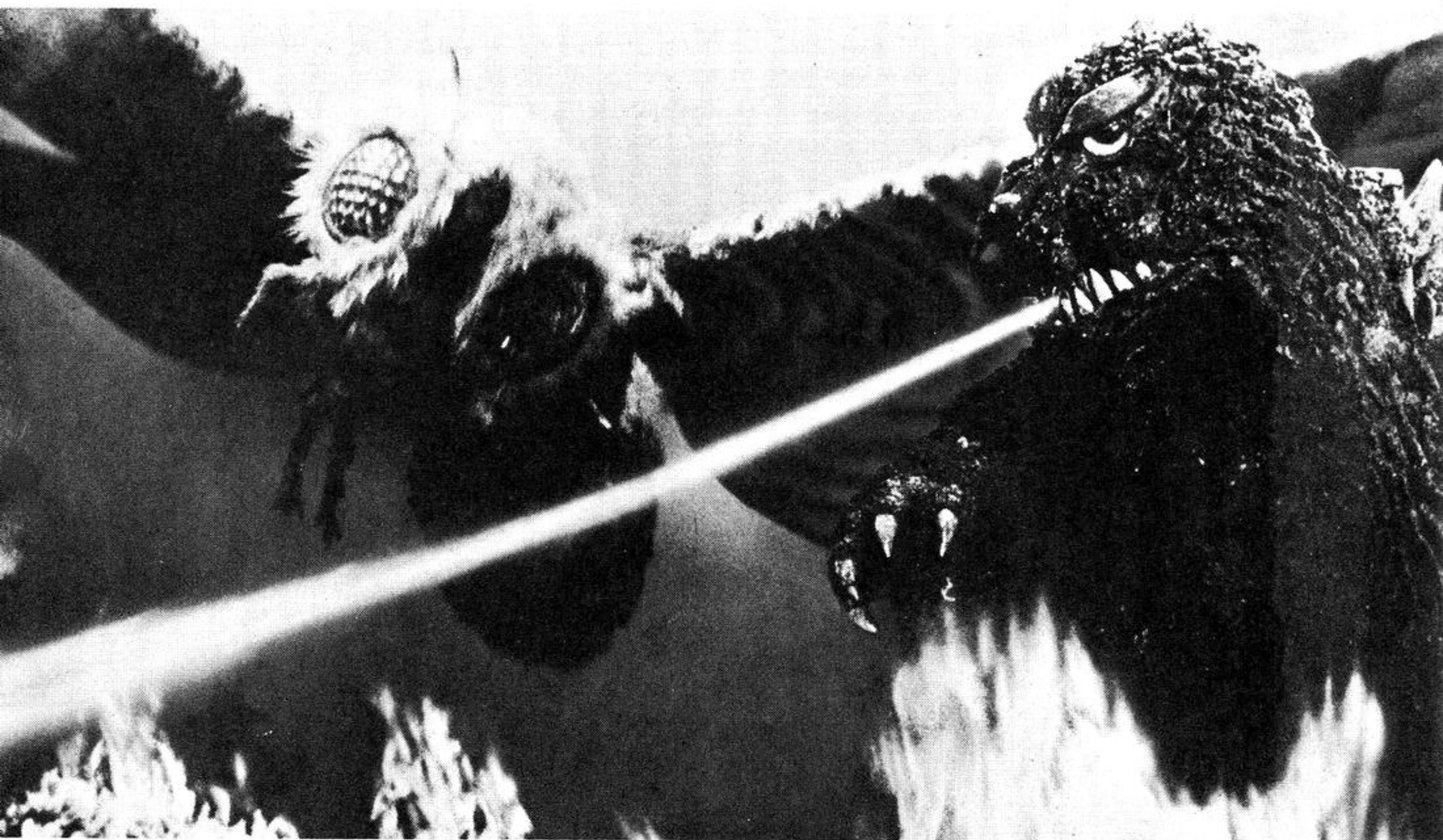

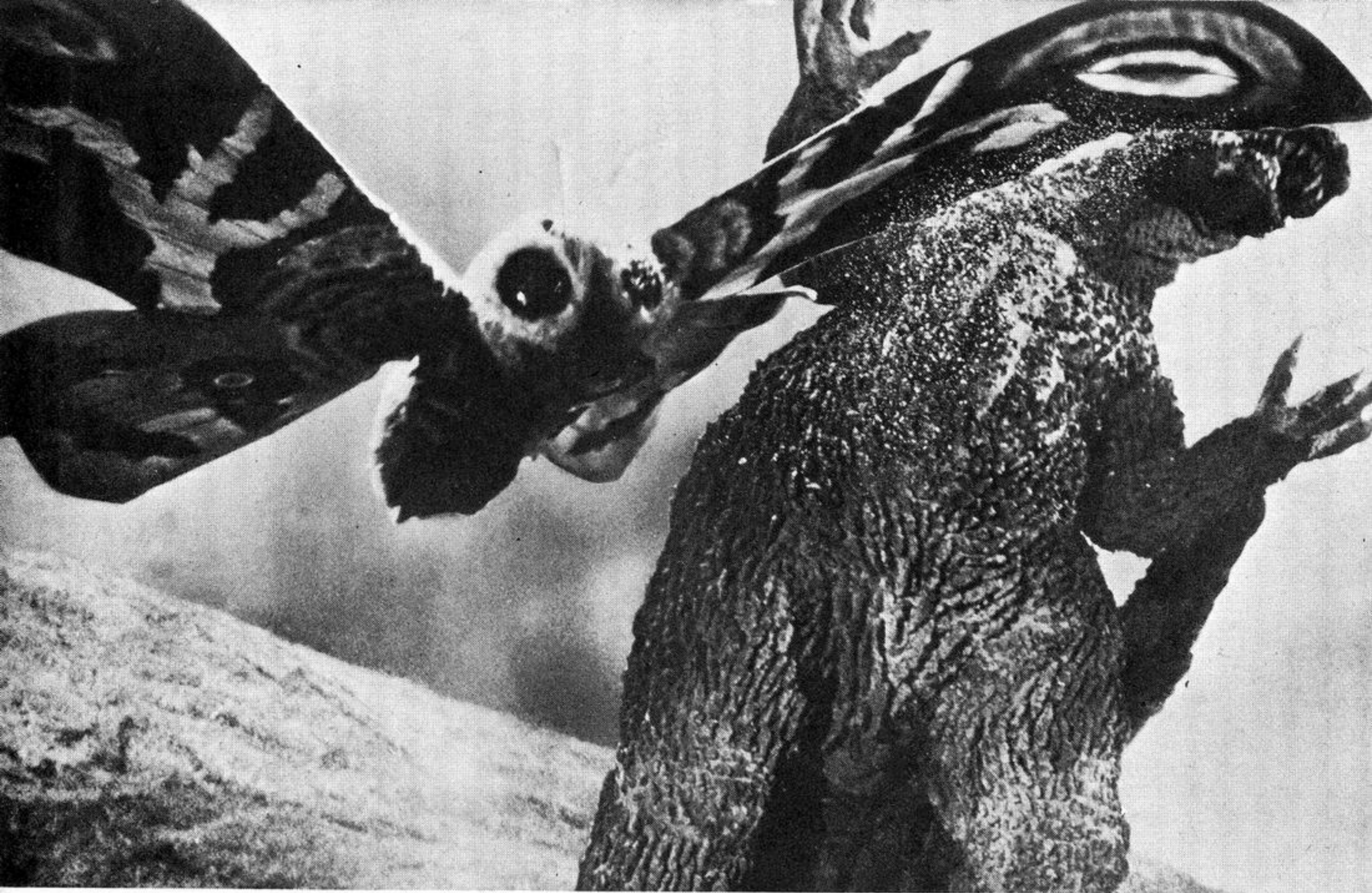

In hideous close-up detail we see the ferocious head of the towering terror from Time's past as it does battle with the winged menace from the island of mystery . . .

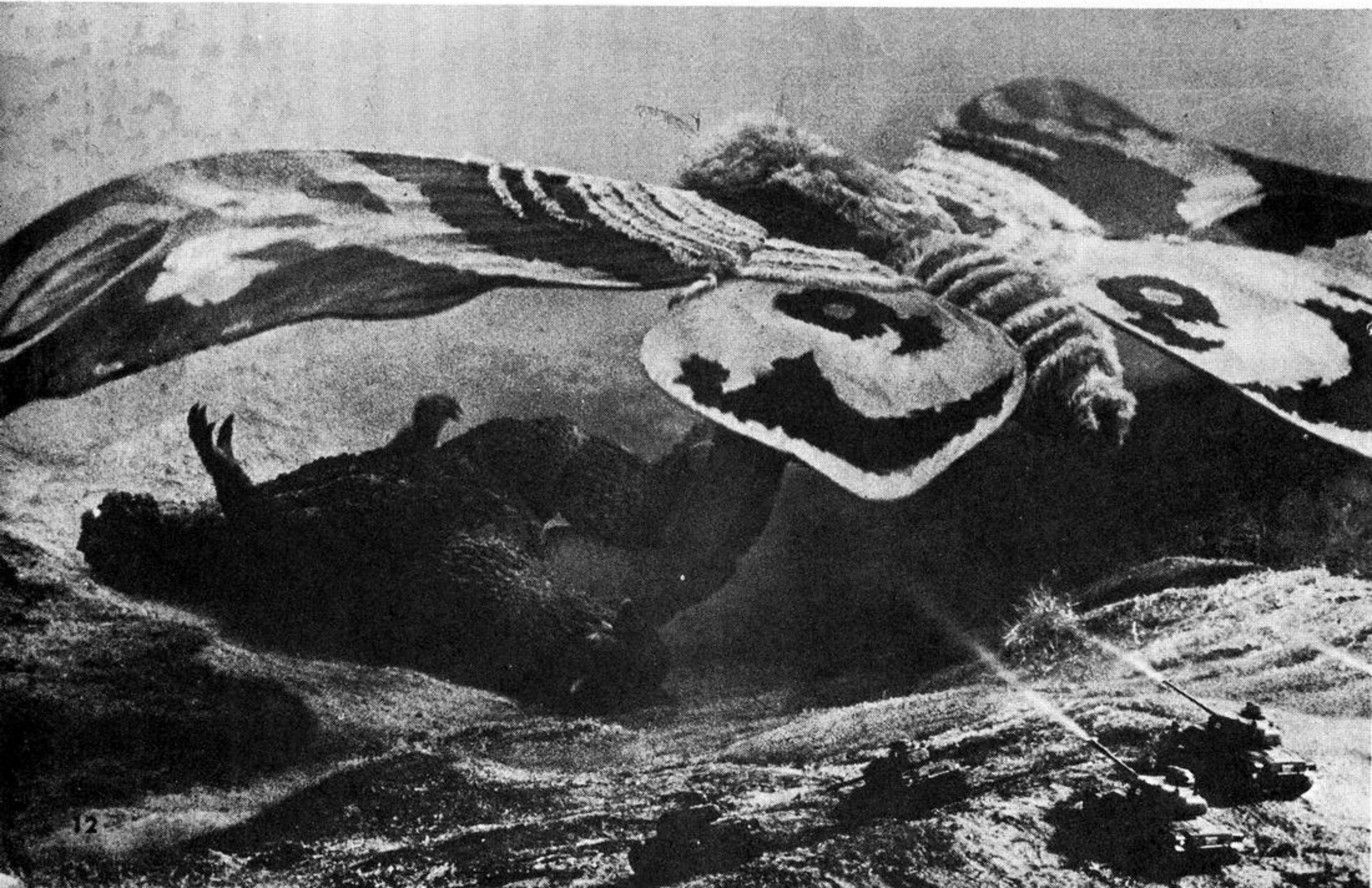

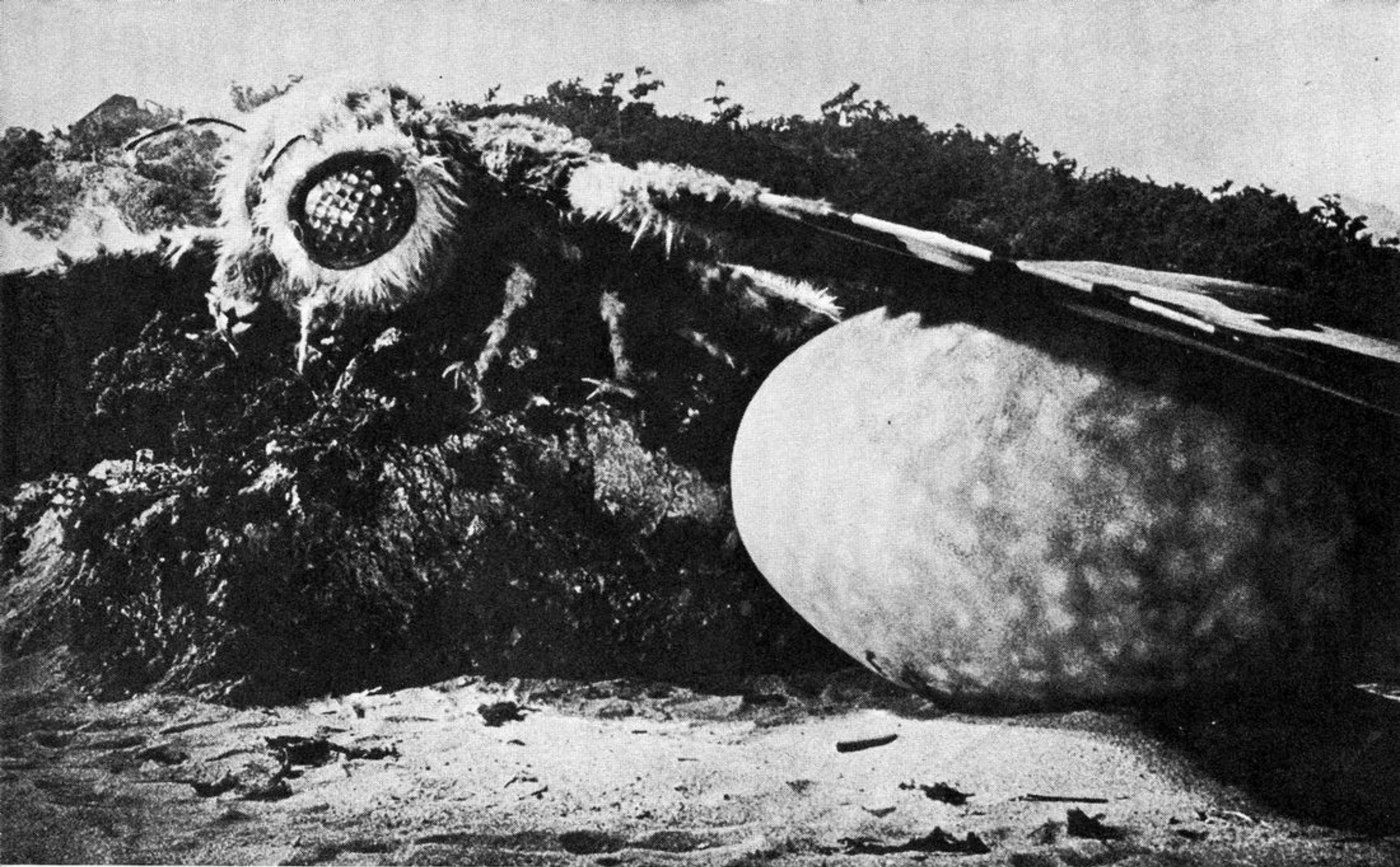
Mothra whaps Godzilla a mighty blow with one of her powerful wings . . .
