

## THE ENEMIES OF JAMES BOND

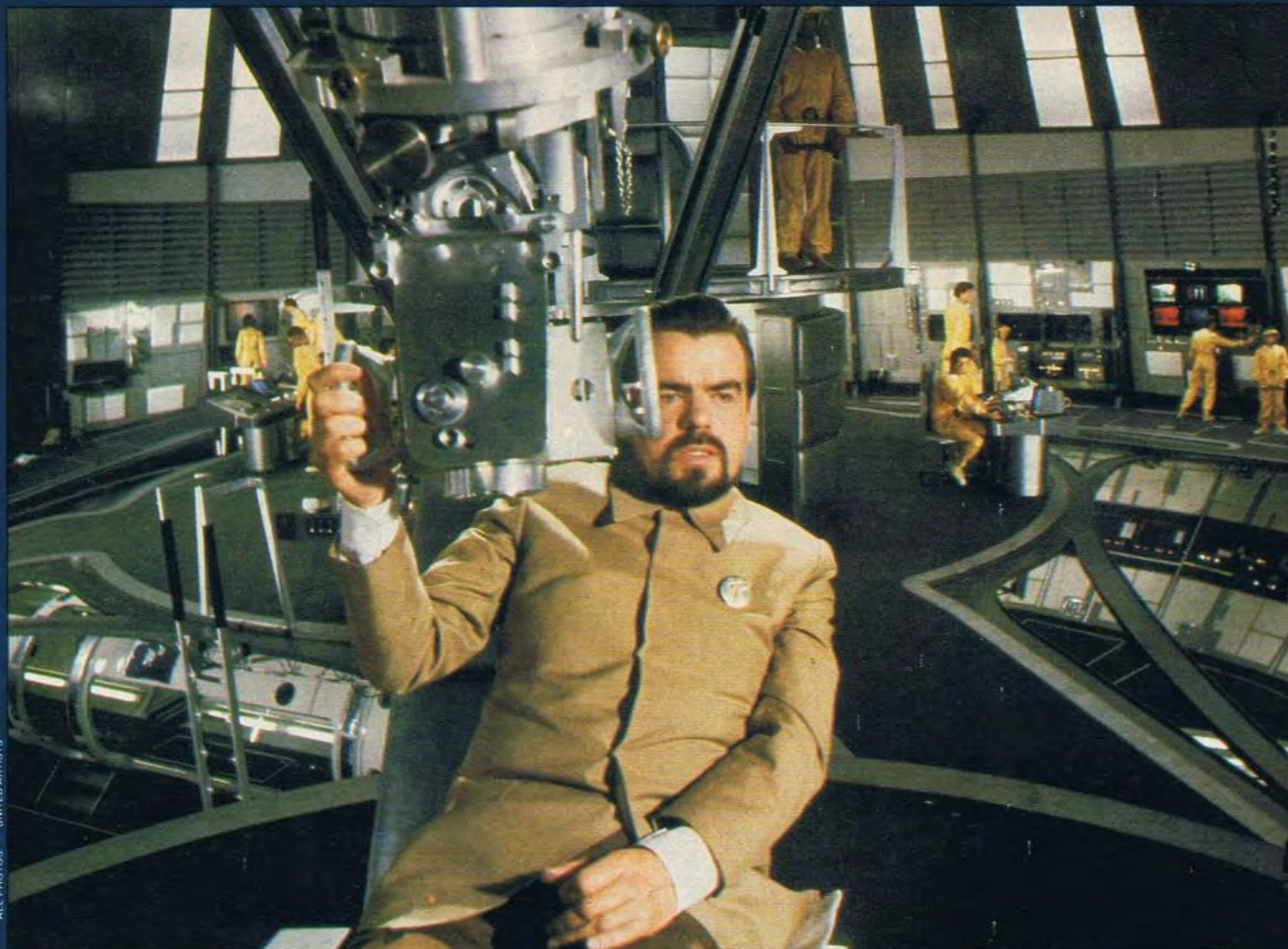

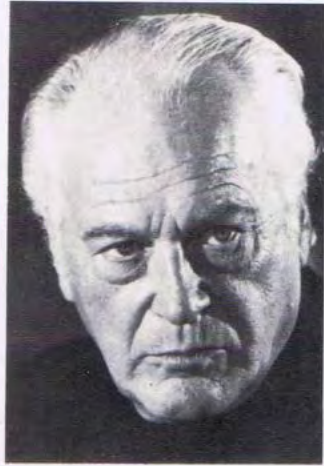


Richard Kiel, as Jaws, prepares to do in Bond in *Moonraker*.
